**THE ST. PETER'S CWL WOULD LIKE TO THANK:** all the kind parishioners who have been bringing food for the food banks. We sincerely appreciate these donations and ask you to please continue your generosity as the need is great. Thank you so much!

**THE ST. LAWRENCE-ST. THERESA CWL COUNCIL:** will be disbanding at the end of 2022. In its place, members will be forming a Catholic Women's Action group, CWA. Reasons for the disbanding include the steep rise in membership dues on the horizon (Most of our members are seniors on fixed income); the main focus of the League now is on national and international issues as opposed to provincial and local; the League is moving almost exclusively to online communication re League Magazine and yearly reports, etc. which is difficult if not impossible for many of our senior members to take part in; the League is asking Council executive positions to double up on responsibilities to decrease the number of convenerships which will make finding conveners more of a challenge. 85% of our members voted to leave the League to form our own local action group. Our hope too is that we will attract more younger ladies in our parishes to join when all the focus is on helping at the community and provincial level with much fewer organizational challenges.
