**THE HOLY SACRIFICE OF THE MASS
AND UNIVERSAL HEALING**

Of all of the possible remedies for healing wounded humanity, past, present and future there is an all-powerful means that we have at our disposal: the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. Of all the prayers that can be offered in the past, present and the future, there is no more powerful and efficacious prayer than the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. It is truly the *opus Dei*—the great work of God Himself. It is actually God offering Himself to God; Jesus (the Second Person of the Trinity) offers Himself into the hands of His Heavenly Father through the power of the Holy Spirit and for the salvation of humanity.
