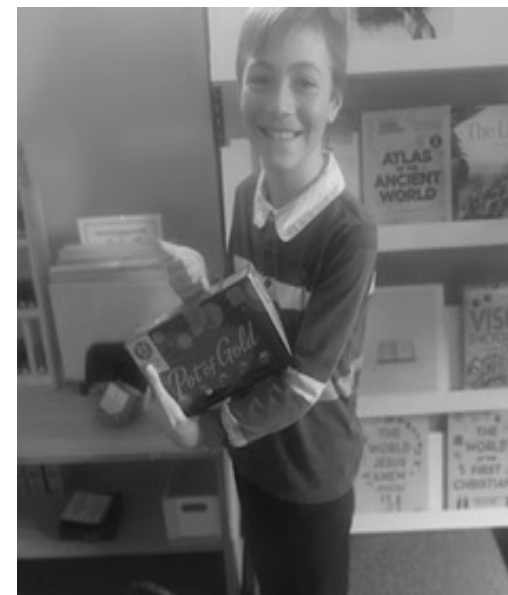
**K OF C ROSARY:** The Knights of Columbus will be saying the rosary the last Sunday of each month, beginning at 8:40. All are welcome to join us.
